## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**Control of Traffic (Belfast) (No. 2) (Amendment)  
Order (Northern Ireland) 1991**

*Made* . . . . . 9th April 1991

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 21st May 1991

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(2)(b) and 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Traffic (Belfast) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 21st May 1991.

*Amendment*

2. In Schedule 2 to the Control of Traffic (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987(c) the item relating to Donegall Street shall cease to have effect.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order amends the Control of Traffic (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987 (S.R. 1987 No. 159).

The effect of the amendment is to restore the right-hand turn from Donegall Street, Belfast, into North Queen Street for vehicles travelling in a northerly direction along Donegall Street.
