## LOCAL GOVERNMENT

**Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991**

*Made* . . . . . 8th May 1991

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 24th June 1991

*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3)*

*of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 24th June 1991.

*General grant*

2. For the purposes of paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 the districts specified for the year ending 31st March 1992 shall be the districts listed below—
