DANGEROUS DRUGS

Misuse of Drugs (Designation) (Variation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991

Made 7th January 1991 Coming into operation 1st February 1991

The Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred by section 7(4) and (5) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971(a) as adapted by section 7(9) of that Act and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and on the recommendation of the Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs, hereby makes the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Designation) (Variation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1991.

Interpretation

- 2.—(1) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(c) shall apply to this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.
- (2) In this Order the "principal Order" means the Misuse of Drugs (Designation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987(d).

Amendment of the principal Order

- 3.—(1) In Article 3(1) and (2) of the principal Order, for the references to "Part 1" there shall be substituted "Part I".
- (2) The principal Order shall be varied by the addition, at the end of paragraph 1(a) of Part I of the Schedule, of "N-Hydroxy-tenamphetamine" and "4-Methyl-aminorex".

Dangerous Drugs EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order varies the Misuse of Drugs (Designation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987 ("the principal Order") by adding to Part I of the Schedule (which specifies the controlled drugs which are designated as drugs to which section 7(4) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 applies) N-Hydroxy-tenamphetamine and 4-Methyl-aminorex. These drugs become subject to control under that Act by virtue of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (Modification) Order 1990 (S.I. 1990/2589).

Incorrect references to Part I of the Schedule in Article 3(1) and (2) of the principal Order are also amended.
