**School Admissions (Appeal Tribunals) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991**

<i>Made</i>	21st May 1991
<i>Coming into operation</i>	31st May 1991

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 37(7) and 164(6) of the Education Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1989(a), Article 134(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the School Admissions (Appeal Tribunals) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 31st May 1991.

*Amendment of the School Admissions (Appeal Tribunals) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990*

2. The School Admissions (Appeal Tribunals) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990(c) shall be amended as follows—

(a) in Schedule 1—

(i) in paragraph 1 for the words “six members” there shall be substituted the words “three members”;

(ii) in paragraph 3 for the words “two persons” wherever they occur there shall be substituted the words “a person”;

(b) in Schedule 2 in paragraph 8 the words from and including “and in the case of an equality of votes” to the end shall be omitted.

*Transitional provision*

3.—(1) These Regulations shall not apply in respect of an appeal by a notice in writing signed before 31st May 1991.

(2) In this Regulation “appeal” means an appeal by virtue of Article 37 of the Education Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1989.

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations amend the School Admissions (Appeal Tribunals) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1990 ("the 1990 Regulations") by providing that an appeal tribunal shall consist of three members instead of six members, the membership to comprise one person from each of the panels provided for in paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the 1990 Regulations. The Regulations also omit the provision enabling the chairman of an appeal tribunal to have a second or casting vote.

These Regulations do not apply in respect of an appeal by a notice in writing signed before the coming into operation of these Regulations.
