Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1991

Made . . . . . 29th November 1991

Coming into operation . . . . . 31st January 1992

The Foyle Fisheries Commission in exercise of its powers under section 13(1) and (2) of the Foyle Fisheries Act 1952(a), and section 13(1) and (2) of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1952(b), with the approval of the minister for the Marine in the Republic of Ireland(c) and of the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland(d), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1991 and shall come into operation on 31st January 1992.

Amendment to the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations 1976

2. There shall be substituted for the Schedule to the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations 1976(e), the following Schedule:—
