The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 6(2), 22 and 27 of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and now vested in him(b), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

#### Citation, commencement and revocation

**1.**—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Prospective Cost) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 6th April 1992.

(2) The Legal Advice and Assistance (Prospective Cost) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991(c) are hereby revoked.

#### Financial limit on prospective cost of advice and assistance

2. For the limit of  $\pounds 84.00$  specified in Article 6(2) of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(d) there shall be substituted the limit of  $\pounds 86.50$ .

# Legal Aid and Advice EXPLANATORY NOTE

## (This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations revoke and replace the Legal Advice and Assistance (Prospective Cost) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991 to increase from  $\pounds 84.00$  to  $\pounds 86.50$  the limit on the cost of legal advice and assistance provided under Articles 3 and 4 of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 which a solicitor may incur without obtaining the approval of the appropriate authority.
