The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 14, 22 and 27 of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order $1981(\mathbf{a})$ and now vested in him(\mathbf{b}), and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid (Assessment of Resources) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 6th April 1992.

(2) In these Regulations, a regulation or Schedule referred to by number means the Regulation or Schedule so numbered in the Legal Aid (Assessment of Resources) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981(c).

Amendment of Schedule 1

2. Schedule I shall be amended as follows:—

(a) by substituting for rule 5 the following rule:—

"5. Where the person concerned or his spouse is in receipt of income support paid under the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986, the person concerned shall, for the period during which income support is received, be deemed to have a disposable income which does not exceed the figure for the time being specified in Article 12(1)(a) of the Order"; and

- (b) by substituting for paragraph (b) of Rule 6 the following paragraph—
 - "(b) disability living allowance paid under section 37ZA of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Act 1975(d)".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Legal Aid (Assessment of Resources) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981 so as to:

- (a) take account of a new benefit (disability living allowance) introduced by the Disability Living Allowance and Disability Working Allowance (Northern Ireland) Order 1991;
- (b) amend rule 5 of Schedule 1 to provide that during the time a person is in receipt of income support his disposable income is deemed to be less than the lower income limit prescribed by Article 12(1)(a) of the 1981 Order;
- (c) correct an error in rule 6A of Schedule 2; and
- (d) increase the sliding scale of the amount of capital to be disregarded in respect of persons of pensionable age.
