Electricity (Register) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992

The Department of Economic Development, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 52(5) and (6) of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity (Register) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1992.

Interpretation

2. In this Order "the register" means the register maintained by the Director pursuant to Article 52 of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992.

Hours of inspection

3. The contents of the register shall be available for inspection by the public between 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on each working day.

Fees

- 4.—(1) The fee for inspecting the register shall be £1.00.
- (2) The fee for the supply of a copy of, or extract from, any part of the register certified by the Director to be a true copy or extract shall be £1.00 together with 10p for each page supplied.
