Magistrates' Courts Fees (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1992

Made 2nd June 1992

Coming into operation 1st July 1992

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice, and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1992.

2. In paragraph 12 of Schedule 1 to the Magistrates' Courts Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1989(b), for sub-paragraph (h) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph:—

“(h) Application for Article 50 Order— £60·00, plus £2 for each occasion in respect of which the additional permitted hours are sought.”
