**The Horses (Protective Headgear for Young Riders)
(1990 Order) (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992***Made**15th June 1992*

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(2) of The Horses (Protective Headgear for Young Riders) (Northern Ireland) Order 1990(a) and paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as The Horses (Protective Headgear for Young Riders) (1990 Order) (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992.

Commencement

2. The day appointed for the coming into operation of The Horses (Protective Headgear for Young Riders) (Northern Ireland) Order 1990 shall be 1st August 1992.
