# **Docks (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992**

The Department of Agriculture, the Department of Economic Development and the Department of the Environment acting jointly as the Department concerned(a), in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 17(1), (3) and (5) of the Health and Safety at Work (Northern Ireland) Order 1978(b) and of every other power enabling them in that behalf, after consultation in accordance with Article 46(1) of that Order with the Health and Safety Agency for Northern Ireland and such other bodies as appeared to them to be appropriate, hereby make the following Regulations:

#### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Docks (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 2nd November 1992.

#### Amendments to the Docks Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1989

2. Paragraph (3) of regulation 21 of the Docks Regulations (Northern Ireland)  $1989(\mathbf{c})$  shall have effect subject to the following amendments:—

(a) in sub-paragraph (b) the word "and" shall be deleted;

- (b) in sub-paragraph (c)—
  - (i) for the comma there shall be substituted a semi-colon, and

(ii) the word "and" shall be inserted at the end of the sub-paragraph;

- (c) after sub-paragraph (c) there shall be inserted—
  - "(d) any person engaged in the carriage, keeping or supply of any military explosives (within the meaning of regulation 2 of the Classification and Labelling of Explosives Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991(d)) if that person is under the direct supervision of the Ministry of Defence.".

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend regulation 21(3) of the Docks Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1989 (S.R. 1989 No. 320), which, subject to certain conditions, empowers the Secretary of State for Defence to exempt from the provisions of the Regulations specified military personnel and organisations.

The effect of the amendments is to add to those specified categories persons who are under the direct supervision of the Ministry of Defence and who are engaged in the carriage, keeping or supply of military explosives within the meaning of the Classification and Labelling of Explosives Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991 (S.R. 1991 No. 516).
