LANDLORD AND TENANT

The Registered Rents (Increase) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992

Made 9th January 1992 Coming into operation . . 9th March 1992

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(2) and 33(2) of the Rent (Northern Ireland) Order 1978(a) (hereinafter called "the Order") and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, having complied with the requirements of Article 33(1) of the Order and determined that the rents hereinafter mentioned should be increased, hereby makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Registered Rents (Increase) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 9th March 1992.

Increase of registered rents

2. The rents registered under Part V of the Order for dwelling-houses which are let under regulated tenancies shall be increased by 9.5 per cent.

Landlord and Tenant EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This order increases the rents of regulated tenancies registered with the Department of the Environment by 9.5 per cent from 9th March 1992. Under Article 22(4) of the Rent (Northern Ireland) Order 1978 a notice of increase of rent which gives effect to such increases shall not take effect earlier than four weeks after the commencement of this order, i.e., not earlier than 6th April 1992.

Before a landlord may recover an increased rent he must give a tenant at least four weeks' notice of the increase in accordance with Article 22(3)(b).
