Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations 1992

Made 29th September 1992

Coming into operation 1st December 1992

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), and after consulting in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority and the Police Association, hereby with the concurrence of the Treasury makes the following regulations:—

Citation, operation and effect

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations 1992.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st December 1992 but shall have effect for the purposes of regulation 4 as from 31st August 1991 and for the purposes of regulation 5 as from 31st July 1991.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988(c).

Advances of pay

3. In regulation 21 of the principal regulations there shall be added after paragraph (2) the following paragraph—

“(3) The Police Authority may, if they think fit, pay to a member such part of his pay as they may determine in advance of the day on which it would otherwise be due to be paid in accordance with this regulation.”.

4. In regulation 18 of the principal regulations for “£5·21” there shall be substituted “£5·65”.

Women's stocking allowance

5. In Part V of the principal regulations after regulation 24 there shall be inserted the following regulation—

“24A. The Police Authority shall pay to a woman member a stocking allowance at such annual rate as shall be determined by the Secretary of State.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988.

Regulation 3 enables the Police Authority to make advances of pay to members of the force.

Regulation 4 increases the rates of pay for members of the force with effect as from 1st September 1991. (For technical legal reasons the date specified in the regulation is 31st August 1991.).

Regulation 5 provides for the payment of a stocking allowance to women members with effect as from 1st August 1991. (For technical legal reasons the date specified in the regulation is 31st July 1991.).

Retro-spection is authorised by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
