HEALTH AND PERSONAL SOCIAL SERVICES**General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services
(Amendment No. 3) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992**

Made 22nd October 1992

Coming into operation 2nd November 1992

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 56(2), 63(2), 106(b) and 107(6) of the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and in conjunction with the Department of Finance and Personnel(b) and after consultation with such organisations as appeared to the Department to be representative of the Medical and Pharmaceutical professions, as required by Articles 56(5) and 63(3) of the said Order, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services (Amendment No. 3) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 2nd November 1992.

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Health and Personal Social Services (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(c).

Amendments to the principal regulations

2. In paragraph (3) of regulation 4 of the principal regulations (medical list) the words “, resident in Northern Ireland” shall be omitted.

3. In Schedule 3A to the principal regulations (drugs and other substances not to be prescribed for supply under pharmaceutical services)—

(a) the following entries shall be omitted—

Cyanocobalamin tablets (any strength)

Emulave

Infra-Care Baby Bath

Savlon Baby Care Cream;

- (c) in the entry for "Rite-Diet Gluten-Free Biscuits", for "half-coated", there shall be substituted "milk".

4. In Schedule 3B to the principal regulations (drugs and other substances to be prescribed for supply under pharmaceutical services only in certain circumstances)—

- (a) after the entries relating to Clobazam, there shall be inserted in Columns 1, 2 and 3 respectively the following—

"Cyanocobalamin	A patient who is a vegan or who has a proven vitamin B12 deficiency of dietary origin	Treatment or preven- tion of vitamin B12 deficiency";
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- (b) the following entries shall be inserted in Column 1 of Schedule 3B in the list of contact lens solutions at the appropriate point in the alphabetical order—

Bausch & Lomb Concentrated Cleaner (for Hard Lenses)
 Bausch & Lomb Soaking and Wetting Solution
 Clerz Lubricating, Cleaning & Comfort Sachets

Contactasol Solar Saline Spray
Perform 1 Disinfecting Solution
Perform 2 Rinsing and Neutralising Solution.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

Regulation 2 amends regulation 4 of the Health and Personal Social Services (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 ("the principal regulations") to remove the criterion of residence in Northern Ireland as a condition for entry to the medical list.

Regulation 3 removes some drugs and substances from, and includes others in, Schedule 3A to the principal regulations which contains a list of drugs and other substances for which a doctor may not issue a prescription for supply under pharmaceutical services and which may not be dispensed under those services. Regulation 3 also effects a minor amendment to that list.

Schedule 3B to the principal regulations contains a list of drugs and other substances which may be prescribed for supply under pharmaceutical services only in certain circumstances. Regulation 4(a) inserts a new entry in the list of drugs in Schedule 3B and regulation 4(b) amends that Schedule to include some further contact lens solutions.
