ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1992**

Made 19th February 1992

Coming into operation 2nd April 1992

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(2)(b) and 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 2nd April 1992.

Amendment

2. Schedule 2 to the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986(c) shall be amended by the deletion therefrom of the item relating to Dalton Street, from its junction with Middlepath Street to its junction with Bridge End.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986.

The effect of the amendment is the re-introduction of two-way traffic in Dalton Street, from its junction with Middlepath Street, to its junction with Bridge End.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).
