ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Designation of Relevant External Law) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992

Made 26th November 1992

Coming into operation 1st January 1993

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 5(2)(b) and (c) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Designation of Relevant External Law) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1993.

Designation of relevant external law

2. The law for the time being in force in Jersey which corresponds to Part II of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(b) is hereby designated as one which makes satisfactory provision for—

- (a) tests of competence to drive any class of goods vehicle or any class of passenger-carrying vehicle; and
- (b) the granting of licences to drive any class of goods vehicle or any class of passenger-carrying vehicle.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order designates the law of Jersey as one which makes satisfactory provision for (a) tests of competence to drive goods and passenger-carrying vehicles for the purposes of Article 5(2)(b) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and (b) for the granting of licences to drive such vehicles for the purposes of Article 5(2)(c) of that Order.
