ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Parking Places on Roads (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1993

Made 14th January 1993

Coming into operation 1st March 1993

WHEREAS it appears to the Department of the Environment to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the parts of the roads specified in Schedule 1.

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 104(1)(c) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places on Roads (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1993.

Amendment

2. The Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 1988(b) shall be amended by—

- (a) the addition to the Schedule of the items in Schedule 1;
- (b) the deletion from the Schedule of the items in Schedule 2.

175. High Street, Bangor, (South Side) — from a point approximately 7 metres west of its junction with Beatrice Avenue, for a distance of approximately 7 metres.
176. Ava Drive, Belfast, (East Side) — from a point approximately 25 metres north of its junction with Sunnyside Street, for a distance of approximately 4.5 metres.
177. Bentinck Street, Belfast, (North Side) — from a point approximately 40 metres east of its junction with Cambridge Street, for a distance of approximately 4.5 metres.
178. Ethel Street, Belfast, (North Side) — from a point approximately 46 metres west of its junction with Lisburn Road, for a distance of approximately 10 metres.
179. Meenagh Park, Coalisland, (South-West Side, in front of No. 11) — from a point approximately 80 metres from its junction with Annagher Road, for a distance of approximately 3 metres.
180. Pound Lane, Downpatrick, (North-West Side) — from a point approximately 35 metres west of its junction with John Street, for a distance of approximately 7 metres.
181. Pound Lane, Downpatrick, (North-West Side) — from a point approximately 50 metres west of its junction with John Street, for a distance of approximately 7 metres.
182. Scotch Street, Downpatrick, (South Side) — from a point approximately 125 metres north-east of its junction with Irish Street, for a distance of approximately 7 metres.
183. Mount Street, Dromore, County Down, (South Side) — from a point approximately 141 metres south-east of its junction with Moss Lane, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
184. Paget Lane, Enniskillen, (South-West Side) — from a point approximately 125 metres south-east of its junction with Paget Square, for a distance of approximately 3 metres.
185. Main Street, Limavady, (South Side) — from a point approximately 25 metres north-east of its junction with Connell Street, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
186. Bow Street, Lisburn, (South Side) — from a point approximately 65 metres east of its junction with Market Place, for a distance of approximately 2.5 metres.

187. Sloan Street, Lisburn, (South Side) — from a point approximately 100 metres north-west of its junction with Graham Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
188. Duke Street, Londonderry, (South-East Side) — from a point approximately 38 metres north-east of its junction with Spencer Road, for a distance of approximately 9 metres.
189. Foyle Street, Londonderry, (East Side) — from a point approximately 20 metres north of its junction with Water Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
190. Annahugh Park, Loughgall, (North Side, in front of No. 7) — from a point approximately 36 metres from its junction with Red Lion Road, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
191. Garland Avenue, Lurgan, (South-East Side) — from a point approximately 7 metres south-west of its junction with Garland Drive, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
192. Drumgullion Avenue, Newry, (North-West Side) — from a point approximately 168 metres north-east of its junction with Armagh Road, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
193. Hennessy Park, Newry, (North-East Side, in front of No. 70) — from a point approximately 229 metres from its junction with Courtney Hill, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
194. Conway Square, Newtownards, (Eastern End of parking area) — from a point approximately 2 metres west of the southern extremity of the exit road from Conway Square, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
195. High Street, Omagh, (North Side) — from a point approximately 23 metres east of its junction with Georges Street, for a distance of approximately 3 metres.
196. Main Street, Richhill, (South Side) — from a point approximately 46 metres north-east of its junction with New Line, for a distance of approximately 3.5 metres.
197. Main Street, Strabane, (South-West Side) — from a point approximately 33 metres south-east of its junction with Castle Place, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
198. Meetinghouse Street, Strabane, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 50 metres north-west of its junction with Kennedy Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the provision of the Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 ("the 1988 Order").

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places on the roads specified in Schedule 1 and for the deletion from the Schedule to the 1988 Order of the parking places specified in Schedule 2.
