The Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order (Northern Ireland) 1993

PART II

SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS

**Increase in rate of graduated retirement benefit and increments thereof**

**11.**—(1) The sum of 7·09 pence referred to in section 35(1) of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1966<sup>(1)</sup> (graduated retirement benefit) shall be increased by 3·6 per cent.; and accordingly, from and including 12th April 1993 the reference in that provision to that sum shall have effect as a reference to 7·35 pence.

(2) The sums which are the increases of graduated retirement benefit under Schedule 2 to the Social Security (Graduated Retirement Benefit) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978<sup>(2)</sup> (increases for deferred entitlement to a Category A or Category B retirement pension) shall be increased by 3·6 per cent. of their amount apart from this order.
