PART II

SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS

Increase in rate of graduated retirement benefit and increments thereof

- 11.—(1) The sum of 7.09 pence referred to in section 35(1) of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(1) (graduated retirement benefit) shall be increased by 3.6 per cent.; and accordingly, from and including 12th April 1993 the reference in that provision to that sum shall have effect as a reference to 7.35 pence.
- (2) The sums which are the increases of graduated retirement benefit under Schedule 2 to the Social Security (Graduated Retirement Benefit) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978(2) (increases for deferred entitlement to a Category A or Category B retirement pension) shall be increased by 3·6 per cent. of their amount apart from this order.
