## POLICE

**Royal Ulster Constabulary (Amendment) Regulations 1993**

*Made* . . . . . 6th April 1993

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 31st May 1993

*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 25 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), and after consulting in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority and the Police Association, and after taking into account the recommendations made by the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom and furnishing that board with a draft of the regulations in accordance with section 2(1) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(c), hereby with the concurrence of the Treasury makes the following regulations:—

*Citation, operation and effect*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary (Amendment) Regulations 1993.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 31st May 1993 but shall have effect for the purposes of regulation 3 as from 31st March 1992, and for the purposes of regulations 4 and 5 as from 31st August 1992.

*Interpretation*

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Regulations 1984(d).

*Removal allowance*

3. In paragraph (7) of regulation 43 of the principal regulations for “£1,200” there shall be substituted “£1,257”.

*Pay*

4. In Schedule 5 to the principal regulations for the Tables A, B and C there shall be substituted respectively the Tables set out in the Schedule.

*Dog handler's allowance*

5. In Schedule 11 to the principal regulations in sub-paragraph 1(1)(a) for "£858" there shall be substituted "£915" and in sub-paragraph 1(1)(b) for "£1,176" there shall be substituted "£1,251".

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Regulations 1984 (the principal regulations).

Regulation 3 amends regulation 43 (removal allowance) of the principal regulations to increase the maximum amount payable in respect of incidental expenditure and has effect on and after 1st April 1992.

Regulation 4 increases the rate of pay for members of the force and regulation 5 increases the dog handler's allowance. Both regulations have effect on and after 1st September 1992.

Retrospection is authorised by Section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
