**Prohibition of Traffic (Dunluce Street, Larne) (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1993**

Made 14th September 1993

Coming into operation 1st November 1993

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objections have been received, and 4 representations have been received and duly considered;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 22(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibition of Traffic (Dunluce Street, Larne) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1993.

Amendment

2. The Schedule to the Prohibition of Traffic (Dunluce Street, Larne) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992(b) shall be amended by—

- (a) the insertion in paragraph 2 of the words “or on behalf of” after the word “by”;
- (b) the deletion of paragraph 9.
