Education (Individual Pupils' Achievements) (Information) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1994

Made 28th March 1994

Coming into operation 28th April 1994

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 17A of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(a) and Article 31(2) and (3) of the Education Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 1989(b) ("the 1989 Order") and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and after consulting as required by Article 31(4) of the 1989 Order, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Individual Pupils' Achievements) (Information) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1994 and shall come into operation on 28th April 1994.

Amendment of the Education (Individual Pupils' Achievements) (Information) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991

2. For regulation 8 (Time and manner of provision of information to parents) of the Education (Individual Pupils' Achievements) (Information) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991(c) there shall be substituted—

“8.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) the principal shall send the information (whether by post or otherwise) to the pupil's parent not later than 30th June in the school year to which the information relates.

(2) Where the principal receives information after 30th June in any school year consisting of the results of public examinations taken by a pupil at the school during that school year, he shall send that information (whether by post or otherwise) as soon as reasonably practicable to the parent of that pupil.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Education (Individual Pupils' Achievements) (Information) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991. They change from 30th April to 30th June, the date by which a school principal must supply the parents of each pupil in the final year of Key Stage 2 with information about the pupil's educational achievements. This makes the date for the supply of that information in the case of a pupil who is at the end of Key Stage 2 the same as that for all other Key Stages.
