## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Control of Traffic (Belfast) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1994

*Made* . . . . . 3rd May 1994

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 14th June 1994

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994 and shall come into operation on 14th June 1994.

*Prohibition of right-hand turn*

2. Subject to Article 4 a person shall not cause or permit a vehicle travelling on the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to make a right-hand turn into the roads specified in column 2 while proceeding in the direction specified in column 3.

*Prohibition of left-hand turn*

3. Subject to Article 4 a person shall not cause or permit a vehicle travelling on the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to make a left-hand turn into the roads specified in column 2 while proceeding in the direction specified in column 3.

*Exemptions*

4. Articles 2 and 3 shall not apply to—

(a) vehicles being used for fire brigade, ambulance, police or military purposes; or

(a) S.I. 1981/154 (N.I. 1); see Article 2(2) for the definition of "Department"

(b) a vehicle, the driver of which is acting upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform or of a traffic warden.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order prohibits vehicles travelling along:—

1. Castlereagh Road, Belfast in a north-westerly direction from making a right-hand turn into Beersbridge Road;  
Castlereagh Street, in a south-easterly direction from making a right-hand turn into Beersbridge Road;  
Castlereagh Street, in a north-westerly direction from making a right-hand turn into Clandeboyne Street.
2. Beersbridge Road, Belfast in an easterly direction from making a left-hand turn into Castlereagh Street;  
Castlereagh Street, in a south-easterly direction from making a left-hand turn into Templemore Avenue.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the roads.
