

1994 No. 188**POLICE****Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1994**

Made 22nd April 1994

Coming into operation 1st July 1994

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act, the Police Authority and the Police Association, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1994.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st July 1994.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988(b).

Qualifications for appointment to the force

3. Paragraph (d) of regulation 8(1) shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Part-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988.

Regulation 3 removes the minimum height requirements for appointment to the force.
