The Department of Economic Development, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 14(1) of the Gas (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, on the application of Premier Energy Suppliers Limited, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Gas Undertaker (Premier Energy Suppliers Limited) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994, and shall come into operation on 12th September 1994.

Declaration of an undertaker for the supply of gas

2. Premier Energy Suppliers Limited is hereby declared to be an undertaker for the supply of gas.

Gas EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order declares Premier Energy Suppliers Limited to be an undertaker for the supply of gas. That Company will accordingly have the powers (including powers to acquire land compulsorily) and duties of a gas undertaker under the Gas (Northern Ireland) Order 1977.

Medicines (Advertising) Regulations 1994

These Regulations have been made by the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972, and the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health in England, in Wales and in Scotland and the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, acting jointly in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sections 61, 66(l)(i) and (j), 95(1)(2)(3)(4)(5) and (6) and 129(5) of the Medicines Act 1968, or as the case may be, those conferred by the said provisions and now vested in them, and those Ministers together with the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with agriculture in Scotland and in Wales and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 85(1), 86(1) and 91(2) of the Medicines Act 1968.

In pursuance of paragraph 11 of Schedule 4 to that Act these Regulations have been registered as a Northern Ireland statutory rule under the Statutory Rules (Northern Ireland) Order 1979. They are printed in full in the volume of United Kingdom Statutory Instruments for 1994 and have been numbered 1932 in that series.
