# Bus Lane (Nelson Street, Belfast) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994

Made . 19th September 1994 Coming into operation . 24th October 1994

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received:

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Bus Lane (Nelson Street, Belfast) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994 and shall come into operation on 24th October 1994.

#### Revocation

2. The Bus Lane (Nelson Street, Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1983(b) is hereby revoked.

The effect of this Order is to extinguish the bus lane in that length of Nelson Street, Belfast, which extends from a point approximately 140 metres south of its junction with Dock Street to its junction with York Link and which is bounded on the east by the eastern kerbline of Nelson Street and on the west by a kerbed island.

# Medicines (Pharmacy and General Sale-Exemption) Amendment Order 1994
