NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994 and shall come into operation on 4th January 1995.

Amendment

2. The Schedule to the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) shall be amended by the substitution for the items relating to Shore Road of the items specified in the Schedule.

Road Traffic and Vehicles EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 as follows—

- (1) it redefines more precisely the existing items relating to Shore Road, Belfast; and
- (2) it re-introduces the prohibition on waiting by vehicles (which was revoked by the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993) during the morning and evening peak traffic periods on both sides of Shore Road, Newtownabbey, from a point approximately 20 metres south of Mount Street to a point approximately 13 metres south-west of Silverstream Banks (but excluding 3 lengths of road which adjoin Shore Road on its western side and which are also known as Shore Road).

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will be displayed on the road.
