**Control of Traffic (Woodhouse Street, Portadown) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1994**

Made 2nd December 1994

Coming into operation 16th January 1995

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 21(1) and 22(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Traffic (Woodhouse Street, Portadown) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994 and shall come into operation on 16th January 1995.

Amendment

2. Schedule 2 to the One-Way Traffic (Portadown) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980(b) shall be amended by the addition of the item specified in the Schedule.

Revocation

3. The Control of Traffic (Station Subway, Woodhouse Street, Portadown) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972(c) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Portadown) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980 by providing for the introduction of one-way traffic in part of Woodhouse Street, Portadown.

This Order also revokes the Control of Traffic (Station Subway, Woodhouse Street, Portadown) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
