Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations 1994

Made 7th February 1994

Coming into operation . . . 31st March 1994

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), after consulting in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority and the Police Association, hereby with the concurrence of the Treasury makes the following regulations:—

Citation, operation and effect

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations 1994.
- (2) These regulations shall come into operation on 31st March 1994 but shall have effect for the purposes of regulation 3 as from 31st March 1993, and for the purposes of regulations 4 and 5 as from 31st August 1993.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988(c).

Removal allowance

3. In paragraph (6) of regulation 38 of the principal regulations for "£1,257" there shall be substituted "£1,290".

Pay

4. There shall be substituted for the Table in Schedule 3 to the principal regulations the Table set out in the Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Full-Time) (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations 1988 (the principal regulations).

Regulation 3 amends regulation 38 (removal allowance) of the principal regulations to increase the maximum amount payable in respect of incidental expenditure and has effect on and after 1st April 1993.

Regulation 4 increases the rate of pay for members of the force and regulation 5 increases the dog handler's allowance. Both regulations have effect on and after 1st September 1993.

Retrospection is authorised by Section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
