## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1994**

*Made* . . . . . 10th March 1994

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 21st April 1994

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994 and shall come into operation on 21st April 1994.

*Amendment*

2. Schedule 2 to the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986(b) shall be amended by the deletion therefrom of the following items—

<i>Column 1</i>	<i>Column 2</i>
St. Andrew's Square North, from its junction with St. Andrew's Square West to its junction with St. Andrew's Square East	Easterly from St. Andrew's Square West
St. Andrew's Square East, from its junction with St. Andrew's Square North to its junction with Hope Street	Southerly from St. Andrew's Square North

This Order amends the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Belfast) Order

St. Andrew's Square East and in part of St. Andrew's Square North, Belfast.
