Public Use of the Records (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1995

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Public Records Act (Northern Ireland) 1923(a) and paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and now vested in it(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Rules:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Public Use of the Records (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 3rd April 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Rules.).

These Rules amend the Public Record Office (Public Use of the Records) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1953 by substituting a new schedule setting out the fees payable for the inspection, search or copying of certain public records and for the handling and certification of such copies. These Rules provide for increases in the fees charged by the Public Record Office of Northern Ireland and introduce a new business fee for searching and handling in response to written requests from legal firms regarding wills and grants.
