TRANSITIONAL AND SAVINGS PROVISIONS AND REVOCATIONS

Claim or question concerning sickness or invalidity benefit to be determined after the appointed day

24. For the purpose of determining any claim or question concerning sickness or invalidity benefit which falls to be determined on or after the appointed day, the Contributions and Benefits Act, the Administration Act, and any regulations made thereunder (other than the Social Security (Claims and Payments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(1)) shall be construed as if Article 15(2) of the Social Security (Incapacity for Work) (Northern Ireland) Order 1994 had not been made.
