One-Way Traffic (Londonderry) (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Londonderry) (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 28th August 1995.

Amendment

2. Schedule 2 to the One-Way Traffic (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) shall be amended by the addition thereto of the following item—

Column 1	Column 2
Foyle Street, from its junction with Water Street, to a point approximately 140 metres south of that junction	Southerly from Water Street

Road Traffic and Vehicles EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the One-Way Traffic (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981.

The amendment provides for the introduction of a one-way traffic system in that part of Foyle Street, Londonderry from its junction with Water Street, to a point approximately 140 metres south of that junction.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£1,000).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
