**Parking Places on Roads (Amendment No. 3) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1995**

Made 2nd August 1995

Coming into operation 18th September 1995

WHEREAS it appears to the Department of the Environment to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the parts of the roads specified in the Schedule;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 104(1)(c) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places on Roads (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 18th September 1995.

Amendment

2. The Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 1993(b) shall be amended by the addition to Schedule 1 to that Order of the items in the Schedule.

322. Ballinahone Avenue, Armagh, (South Side, to the rear of No. 72) — from a point approximately 23 metres from its junction with Orangefield Drive, for a distance of approximately 2.5 metres in a westerly direction.
323. Orangefield Close, Armagh, (North Side) — from a point approximately 25 metres west of its junction with Orangefield Park, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
324. Upper English Street, Armagh, (South-West Side) — from a point approximately 5 metres south-east of its junction with Abbey Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
325. Huntly Bungalows, Banbridge, (West Side, in front of No. 35) — from a point approximately 106 metres from its junction with Huntly Road, for a distance of approximately 5 metres in a westerly direction.
326. Ballyferris Mews, Bangor, (East Side) — from a point approximately 31 metres north of its junction with Craigboy Mews, for a distance of approximately 3.5 metres.
327. Bridge Street, Bangor, (East Side) — from a point approximately 26 metres south-west of its junction with High Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
328. Drumhoy Drive, Carrickfergus, (West Side) — from a point approximately 79 metres south of its junction with Northland, for a distance of approximately 3 metres.
329. Main Street, Castlederg, (East Side) — from a point approximately 10 metres south-east of its junction with John Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
330. The Diamond, Castlederg, (West Side) — from a point approximately 47 metres south-west of its junction with John Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
331. Henderson Avenue, Conlig, (West Side) — from a point approximately 45 metres south of its junction with Tower Road, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
332. Clonmeen, Craigavon, (South-West Side of cul-de-sac, in front of No. 217) — from a point approximately 368 metres from its junction with Drumgor Road, for a distance of approximately 3 metres in a north-westerly direction.
333. Moyraverty Court, Craigavon, (North-West Side, in front of No. 117) — from a point approximately 206 metres from its junction with Moyraverty Road, for a distance of approximately 5 metres in a north-westerly direction.
334. St. Dillons Avenue, Downpatrick, (West Side, in front of No. 30) — from a point approximately 110 metres south of its junction with Edward Street, for a distance of approximately 6.5 metres.

335. Saul Street, Downpatrick, (West Side of central island) — from a point approximately 15 metres north-east of its junction with Scotch Street, for a distance of approximately 3.5 metres.
336. Downshire Road, Holywood, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 67 metres north-west of its junction with Downshire Place, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
337. Downshire Road, Holywood, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 60 metres south-east of its junction with Downshire Place, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
338. Downshire Road, Holywood, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 78 metres south-east of its junction with Downshire Place, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
339. Spencer Street, Holywood, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 48 metres south-east of its junction with Church View, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
340. The Willows, Lurgan, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 15 metres north-west of its junction with Donard Gardens, for a distance of approximately 5.5 metres.
341. Central Promenade, Newcastle, (West Side) — from a point approximately 67 metres north of its junction with Post Office Lane, for a distance of approximately 6.5 metres.
342. Ballinlare Gardens, Newry, (South Side, adjacent to No. 10) — from a point approximately 98 metres north of its junction with Killeavy Road, for a distance of approximately 4 metres.
343. Drumgullion Avenue, Newry, (West Side, in front of No. 122) — from a point approximately 300 metres from its junction with Armagh Road, for a distance of approximately 3 metres in a northerly direction.
344. Innisfree Park, Newry, (West Side, in front of No. 17) — from a point approximately 160 metres from its southern junction with Betty's Hill Road, for a distance of approximately 5.5 metres in a southerly direction.
345. Mourne View Park, Newry, (West Side, in front of No. 66) — from a point approximately 157 metres north of its junction with Erskine Street, for a distance of approximately 5.5 metres.
346. Violet Hill Avenue, Newry, (North-East Side, in front of No. 48) — from a point approximately 210 metres from its junction with Armagh Road, for a distance of approximately 5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
347. Cannon Dale, Omagh, (East Side, in front of No. 65) — from a point approximately 6 metres north of its south-eastern extremity, for a distance of approximately 3 metres.

348. Glenview Cottages, Omagh, (North-West Side) — from a point approximately 88 metres south-west of its junction with Kevlin Road, for a distance of approximately 3 metres.
349. High Street, Omagh, (North Side) — from a point approximately 47 metres east of its junction with George's Street, for a distance of approximately 3 metres.
350. Clonavon Avenue, Portadown, (North Side) — from a point approximately 99 metres east of its junction with Thomas Street, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
351. Corcrair Drive, Portadown, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 27 metres north-west of its junction with Corcrair Avenue, for a distance of approximately 2 metres.
352. George Street, Portadown, (South Side) — from a point approximately 28 metres west of its junction with Thomas Street, for a distance of approximately 4.5 metres.
353. Levaghery Gardens, Portadown, (North-East Side, in front of No. 18) — from a point approximately 190 metres from its junction with Gilford Road, for a distance of approximately 4.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
354. Wayside, Tandragee, (East Side, in front of No. 50) — from a point approximately 114 metres from its junction with Portadown Road, for a distance of approximately 3 metres in a southerly direction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 1993.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places on the parts of the roads specified in the Schedule.
