Made 30th September 1995

Coming into operation 20th November 1995

*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of
Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(2) of the Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor-General and Others) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973(a) and now vested in me(b) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order:

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Salaries (Parliamentary Commissioner and Commissioner for Complaints) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 20th November 1995.

Revocation

2. The Salaries (Parliamentary Commissioner and Commissioner for Complaints) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994(c) is hereby revoked.

Increase in salaries

3. The annual salaries payable to the Parliamentary Commissioner and the Commissioner for Complaints shall be increased from £66,511 to £69,175 from 1st April 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order provides for an increase in the annual salaries payable to the Northern Ireland Parliamentary Commissioner for Administration and the Northern Ireland Commissioner for Complaints following the recommendation made in the Report of the Review Body on Senior Salaries in 1995 (HMSO CM 2764).

These increases are made with retrospective effect from 1st April 1995 under Article 4(2) of the Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor-General and Others) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973.

Article 2 revokes the Salaries (Parliamentary Commissioner and Commissioner for Complaints) Order (Northern Ireland) 1994.
