## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**Parking Places on Roads (Amendment No. 5) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1995**

*Made* . . . . . 28th December 1995

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 8th February 1996

WHEREAS it appears to the Department of the Environment to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the parts of the roads specified in Schedule 1;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 104(1)(c) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places on Roads (Amendment No. 5) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 8th February 1996.

*Amendment*

2. The Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 1993(b) shall be amended by—

- (a) the addition to Schedule 1 to that Order of the items in Schedule 1;
- (b) the deletion from Schedule 1 to that Order of the items in Schedule 2.

398. Seacliff Road, Bangor, (North-West Side) — from a point approximately 390 metres south-west of its junction with Ward Avenue, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
399. Bendigo Street, Belfast, (North Side) — from a point approximately 23 metres west of its junction with Ravenhill Road, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
400. Cheviot Avenue, Belfast, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 70 metres south-east of its junction with Holywood Road, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
401. Clarawood Park, Belfast, (North-West Side) — from a point approximately 10 metres south-west of its junction with Knockwood Park, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
402. College Park Avenue, Belfast, (North Side) — from a point approximately 32 metres east of its junction with Rugby Road, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
403. College Street, Belfast, (North Side) — from a point approximately 15 metres east of its junction with Queen Street, for a distance of approximately 12 metres.
404. Dunraven Avenue, Belfast, (North-West Side) — from a point approximately 62 metres south-west of its junction with Bloomfield Road, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
405. Larkfield Gardens, Belfast, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 185 metres south-east of its junction with Larkfield Drive, for a distance of approximately 2.5 metres.
406. Malone Avenue, Belfast, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 84 metres north-west of its junction with Eglantine Gardens, for a distance of approximately 5.5 metres.

407. Mayfair Avenue, Belfast, (West Side) — from a point approximately 35 metres north of its junction with Montgomery Road, for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
408. Victoria Square, Belfast, (North Side) — from a point approximately 15 metres west of its junction with Upper Church Lane, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
409. Salia Avenue, Carrickfergus, (South Side of cul-de-sac, to the rear of No. 78) — from a point approximately 160 metres from its junction with Northland, for a distance of approximately 3 metres in a westerly direction.
410. Hartford Park, Coleraine, (South-West Side) — from a point approximately 14 metres south-east of its junction with Richmond Drive, for a distance of approximately 3.4 metres.
411. Union Street, Coleraine, (North Side) — from a point approximately 65 metres west of its junction with Brook Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
412. Union Street, Coleraine, (South Side) — from a point approximately 18 metres east of its junction with Martin's Brae, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
413. St Dympna's Park, Downpatrick, (West Side) — from a point approximately 52 metres south of its junction with Oriel Drive, for a distance of approximately 3.5 metres.
414. Saul Street, Downpatrick, (West Side) — from a point approximately 88 metres north-east of its western junction with Scotch Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
415. Dunavon Park, Dungannon, (West Side) — from a point approximately 150 metres south of its junction with Lurgaboy Lane, for a distance of approximately 3 metres.
416. High Street, Holywood, (North-West Side) — from a point approximately 15 metres south-west of its junction with Hibernia Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
417. High Street, Holywood, (South-East Side) — from a point approximately 15 metres south-west of its junction with Church Road, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
418. Hillview Place, Holywood, (North-East Side of south-eastern cul-de-sac, in front of No. 22) — from a point approximately 10 metres south-east of its northern extremity, for a distance of approximately 3.5 metres.
419. Strangford View, Killyleagh, (South Corner of cul-de-sac, to the rear of No. 8) — from a point approximately 56 metres south-west of its junction with Irish Street, for a distance of approximately 3.2 metres.
420. Market Street, Magherafelt, (South-West Side) — from a point approximately 55 metres south-east of its junction with Queen Street, for a distance of approximately 7 metres.

421. Ballymacruise Drive, Millisle, (West Side, opposite No. 4) — from a point approximately 120 metres from its junction with Main Street, for a distance of approximately 3 metres in a southerly direction.
422. Moyne Gardens, Newtownards, (South Side, adjacent to No. 25) — from a point approximately 75 metres from its junction with Upper Greenwell Street, for a distance of approximately 3 metres in an easterly direction.
423. Regent Street, Newtownards, (North Side) — from a point approximately 83 metres west of its junction with Mary Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
424. The Square, Portaferry, (North Side) — from a point approximately 9 metres west of its junction with High Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
425. Ramore Street, Portrush, (East Side) — from a point approximately 25 metres north of its junction with Main Street, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.
426. Main Street, Strabane, (North-East Side) — from a point approximately 44 metres south-east of its junction with Castle Place, for a distance of approximately 6 metres.

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#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order further amends the Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 ("the 1993 Order").

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places on the parts of the roads specified in Schedule 1 and for the deletion from Schedule 1 to the 1993 Order of the parking places specified in Schedule 2.

#### **Medicines (Pharmacies) (Applications for Registration and Fees) Amendment Regulations 1995**

These Regulations have been made by the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health in England, in Wales and in Scotland and the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, acting jointly as the Health Ministers in exercise of powers conferred by sections 75(1), 76(1)(2) and (6) and 129(5) of the Medicines Act 1968.

In pursuance of paragraph 11 of Schedule 4 to that Act these Regulations have been registered as a Northern Ireland statutory rule under the Statutory Rules (Northern Ireland) Order 1979. They are printed in full in the volume of United Kingdom Statutory Instruments for 1995 and have been numbered 3029 in that series.
