2. The Traffic Weight Restriction (Hannahstown Hill, Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 1992(b) is hereby revoked.

The effect of this Order is to remove the prohibition on vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes laden or unladen weight travelling in a southerly direction along Hannahstown Hill, Unclassified No. 800, Belfast, between its junction with Upper Springfield Road, Route B38, and its junction with Glen Road, Route A501.
