SCHEDULE 4

Control Measures to be Taken until Suspicion of Disease is Confirmed

- 1. A person shall not—
 - (a) bring on to or remove from the farm at which the outbreak of disease is suspected any fish whether alive or dead, eggs or gametes;
 - (b) dispose of any dead fish or their offal at that farm except under the supervision of the Department;
 - (c) bring on to or take from that farm any equipment, material or substances liable to transmit disease;
 - (d) enter on to or exit from that farm;
 - (e) bring a vehicle on to or take a vehicle from that farm;
 - (f) remove any fish, whether alive or dead, eggs or gametes from any other farm which is—
 - (i) in the same water catchment area or coastal area as the farm at which the outbreak of disease is suspected, and
 - (ii) whose owners or keepers have been notified that their farm is under surveillance for disease;

without the written authorisation of the Department to do so.
