**1996 No. 374**

**Traffic Weight Restriction (Long Rig Road, Nutts Corner, Crumlin) Order (Northern Ireland) 1996**

**Exceptions**

3. The prohibition in Article 2 shall not apply to a vehicle being used—
- (a) by or on behalf of the owner or occupier of land abutting on or convenient to the road for the purpose of gaining access to such land; or
  - (b) in connection with the delivery to or collection from such land of any goods or livestock or postal packets; or
  - (c) for police or military purposes, or in an emergency for ambulance or fire brigade purposes; or
  - (d) in or adjacent to the road in pursuance of statutory powers and duties by or on behalf of a government department, district council or statutory undertaker; or
  - (e) in or adjacent to the road in connection with the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in section 4(3) of the Telecommunications Act 1984<sup>(1)</sup>.
