REGISTRATION OF CLUBS

Registration of Clubs (Form of Children's Certificate) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997

Made - - - - *21st January 1997*
Coming into operation *20th February 1997*

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 33(10) of the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1996(1) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Registration of Clubs (Form of Children's Certificate) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997 and shall come into operation on 20th February 1997.

Form of Children's Certificate

2. A children's certificate shall be in the form set out in the Schedule.

REGISTRATION OF CLUBS (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1996 CHILDREN'S CERTIFICATE

The above court for the said [District] [Division], in exercise of its powers under Article 33(1) of the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 (hereinafter in this certificate referred to as "the 1996 Order") hereby grants to:—

NOTES

The registered club must keep posted in some conspicuous place in the area to which this certificate relates a notice which states that a children's certificate is in force in relation to the area and explains the effect of the certificate and of any conditions attached to it. A club which fails to do so shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 1 on the standard scale.

PART II

CONDITIONS SUBJECT TO WHICH THIS CERTIFICATE IS GRANTED

1. The certificate shall be operational between the following hours and on the following days:—

(full details of appropriate hours and days to be inserted by the court which grants the certificate)

- 2. Any part of the premises for which this certificate is granted continues to constitute an environment in which it is suitable for a person under the age of 18 to be present.
- 3. Meals and beverages other than intoxicating liquor shall be available for consumption in any part to which this certificate relates at all times when the certificate is operational.
- 4. Any part of the premises to which this certificate relates is equipped and furnished with an adequate number of tables and chairs.
- 5. A person under the age of 18 who is in any part of the premises to which this certificate relates is:
 - in the company of a person who is 18 or over; and
 - seated at a table away from the bar; and
 - there during the time or times when the certificate is operational or when he, or a person in whose company he is, is consuming a meal purchased during the time when the certificate is operational and that in those circumstances no more than 30 minutes have elapsed since the certificate ceased to be operational.
- 6. That any other conditions prescribed by regulations made for the purposes of Article 33 of the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 have been complied with.

PART III

REVOCATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations prescribe the form of children's certificate which is granted by a court in respect of any part of the premises of a registered club which contains a bar or is used exclusively or mainly for the supply, consumption or storage of intoxicating liquor. Children's certificates may be granted under the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 which came into operation on 20th February 1997.
