**Misuse of Drugs (Amendment)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1998**

Amendment of the Misuse of Drugs (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1986

3.—(1) The Misuse of Drugs (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1986⁽¹⁾ shall be amended in accordance with the following provisions.

(2) In paragraph 1(a) of Schedule 1, there shall be inserted—

- (a) after the word “Eticyclidine”, the word “Etryptamine”; and
- (b) after the word “Mescaline”, the word “Methcathinone”.

(3) In paragraph 1 of Schedule 2, after the word “Trimeperidine”, there shall be inserted the word “Zipeprol”.

(4) In paragraph 1(a) of Schedule 3, after the word “Ethinamate”, there shall be inserted the word “Flunitrazepam”.

(5) In paragraph 1 of Part II of Schedule 4⁽²⁾, the word “Flunitrazepam” shall be deleted and there shall be inserted—

- (a) after the word “Alprazolam”, the word “Aminorex”;
- (b) after the word “Bromazepam”, the word “Brotizolam”; and
- (c) after the word “Mefenorex”⁽³⁾, the word “Mesocarb”.
