## SCHEDULE 1

## Text of Articles 30, 31(1) and 34 of the Medical Directive

## **Article 34**

- 1. Without prejudice to the principle of full-time training laid down in Article 31(1)(b), member states may authorise specific part-time training in general medical practice in addition to full-time training where the following particular conditions are met:
  - the total duration of training may not be shortened because it is being followed on a part-time basis,
  - the weekly duration of part-time training may not be less than 60% of weekly full-time training,
  - part-time training must include a certain number of full-time training periods, both for the training conducted at a hospital or clinic and for the training given in an approved centre where doctors provide primary care. These full-time training periods shall be of sufficient number and duration as to provide adequate preparation for the effective exercise of general medical practice.
