**The Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (Costs)
(Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1998**

Made - - - - 21st May 1998

To be laid before Parliament

Coming into operation 29th June 1998

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 36(3) of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981⁽¹⁾, and now vested in him⁽²⁾, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and the Attorney General and with the approval of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Rules:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (Costs) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1998 and shall come into operation on 29th June 1998.

Alteration of date

2. In rules 6(3) and 9(5)(a) of the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (Costs) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1992⁽³⁾ for the date “30th June 1998” there shall be substituted “30th June 1999”.
