## The Human Organ Transplants (Establishment of Relationship) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1998

## Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Human Organ Transplants (Establishment of Relationship) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1998 and shall come into operation on 21st December 1998.
  - (2) In these regulations-
    - "the Order" means the Human Organ Transplants (Northern Ireland) Order 1989;
    - "donor" means the living person from whom it is proposed to remove an organ with the intention that it be transplanted into another person and "recipient" means that other person;
    - "genetic tests" means tests based on DNA variations;
    - "tester" means a person who has been approved by the Department as competent both to specify and to interpret the results of genetic tests.
