Action Programme For Nitrate Vulnerable Zones Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1999

Interpretation

- 2.—(1) In these Regulations—
 - "Appeals Commission" means the Water Appeals Commission for Northern Ireland;
 - "the Department" means the Department of the Environment;
 - "farm" includes livestock unit and has the same meaning which it has in Annex III, paragraph 2, of Council Directive 91/676/EEC concerning the protection of waters against pollution caused by nitrates from agricultural sources(1);
 - "nitrate vulnerable zone" means any area designated as a nitrate vulnerable zone pursuant to regulation 3(2) of the Protection of Water against Agricultural Nitrate Pollution Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996(2).
- (2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(3) shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.
