Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2000

Certificate from a registered medical practitioner or a registered midwife in respect of new or expectant mothers

17. Where—

- (a) a new or expectant mother works at night; and
- (b) a certificate from a registered medical practitioner or a registered midwife shows that it is necessary for her health or safety that she should not be at work for any period of such work identified in the certificate,

the employer shall, subject to Article 99 of the 1996 Order (right to offer of alternative work), suspend her from work for so long as is necessary for her health or safety.
