# The Child Support (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2001

Made . . . . . 9th May 2001 Coming into operation . . 31st May 2001

The Department for Social Development, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 28(1) of the Child Support, Pensions and Social Security Act (Northern Ireland) 2000(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Child Support (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2001 and shall come into operation on 31st May 2001.

Amendment of the Child Support (Collection and Enforcement and Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations

**2.** At the end of regulation 1(2) of the Child Support (Collection and Enforcement and Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2001(**b**) (citation, commencement and interpretation) there shall be added "; and regulation 3(18) and, for the purposes of that provision, this regulation, shall come into operation on 31st May 2001".
