The Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety(**a**) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1(1) and (2) and 24(3) of the Food and Environment Protection Act $1985(\mathbf{b})$ and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, being of the opinion that there no longer exist or may exist circumstances which are likely to create a hazard to human health through human consumption of food and that in consequence food which is derived or may be in the future derived from bivalve molluscs in the area described in the Order revoked by this Order is not, or may not be, or may not become, unsuitable for human consumption, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 2001 and shall come into operation on 3rd October 2001.

(2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(c) shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

2. The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) Order (Northern Ireland) 2001(**d**) is hereby revoked.

This Order revokes the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) Order (Northern Ireland) 2001 which contains emergency prohibitions restricting various activities in order to prevent human consumption of scallops or food which is derived from scallops originating in ICES (International Council for the Exploration of the Sea) Area VIA which are within British fishery limits and which are adjacent to Northern Ireland.
