## Drainage (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2001

#### Part II

#### Drainage Works and Marina Works Generally

# Notification of determination that proposed works are likely to have significant effects on the environment

- 7.—(1) This regulation applies to any case where—
  - (a) under regulation 6(4), the Department determines that any proposed works are likely to have significant effects on the environment; or
  - (b) under regulation 6(7), the Commission determines that any proposed works are likely to have significant effects on the environment.
- (2) In any case to which this regulation applies, the Department shall by notice published in the Belfast Gazette and at least two local newspapers—
  - (a) describe briefly the nature, size and location of the proposed works in question;
  - (b) state that the proposed works are likely to have significant effects on the environment and that the Department intends to prepare an environmental statement in respect of them;
  - (c) indicate whether the proposed works are likely to have significant effects on the environment in another EEA State.
- (3) Where the Department publishes a notice in accordance with paragraph (2) it shall, on or before the date of the publication of the notice in the Belfast Gazette, send a copy of that notice to—
  - (a) the Drainage Council;
  - (b) the district council of the district or, as the case may be, each district in which the proposed works are situate; and
  - (c) any other person who appears to it to have an interest in the matter including, where appropriate, another EEA State.
