LOCAL GOVERNMENT

The Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 2001

Made *31st October 2001* Affirmed by a resolution of the Assembly on . 2001 Coming into operation *31st January* 2002

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 2001 and shall come into operation on 31st January 2002.

General Grant

2. For the purpose of paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 the districts specified for the year ending 31st March 2002 shall be the districts listed below—

Antrim Coleraine Larne Ards Craigavon Lisburn Ballymena Derry(c) Newtownabbey Dungannon and South Tyrone(**d**) Ballymoney North Down Castlereagh Fermanagh Strabane

Revocation

3. The Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1997(e) and the Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1998(**f**) are hereby revoked.
